There is a single mom named Vanessa who comes to church with her two daughters every Sunday. When we first met her, she wanted very little to do with God and church, but over the last ten weeks, she has put her faith in Christ and gone through each level of our discipleship program thus far. She shares Jesus with her coworkers and clients at work, and the joy of the Lord is evident in her life. She is just one example of someone whose life has been forever changed by God.

It's amazing to see how God has brought people from all walks of life who are hurting and searching for truth, and He's given us the opportunity to point them towards Him. Since the start of New Heights, we have been connected with a family whose child is a survivor of the tragedy at Sandy Hook Elementary School, reached coworkers from our secular jobs who may not have been open to the Lord in the past, and connected with people in the community who walked in off the street or were reached through our outreach efforts.
